2. A photo showing the progress of the project will be required at time of entry.
3. No group projects allowed, only one exhibitor per project.
4. Only first and second place exhibits will be considered for the Ag Mechanics Auction. The judge will select up to the top 60 items to go to auction. Third place exhibits are not eligible to sell at auction.
5. Some items may be selected for a silent auction.
6. Exhibitors may establish a minimum for their exhibit. Minimum bids must be declared to Fair Staff upon check in.
7. Exhibitors may sell one project in the Ag Mechanics Auction and one market animal in the Junior Livestock Auction.
8. A commission to be determined by the Nevada County Fair Board will be charged to the seller to promote and finance the sale.
9. Projects must be completed and operational upon receiving. No work, additions or embellishments can be done once the project is received.
10. Exhibitor must be present at auction and at time of sale.
11. All items must be removed from Fairgrounds by 6 pm Monday, August 17. This includes items to be delivered to buyers.
12. No sponsor advertising allowed.
13. No private treaty sales allowed.

Limits: Open to Nevada County Youth Only. Exhibitors can show and sell only one market animal. Exhibitor may not have sold a market animal at any other county fair this year.

1. Market Goats **MUST** have a Scrapie Tag in the right ear.
2. Market goats will weigh a minimum of 65 pounds to 105 pounds maximum.
3. Any market goat weighing over 105 pounds will not be "sifted" from the Livestock Auction, but will not be paid for over 105 pounds.
4. Goats may be does or wethers. However, the does may not exhibit any udder development to be entered as a market goat.
5. All market goats must be dehorned. Spurs not to exceed 2 inches.
6. Goats may be any commercial meat goat or dairy cross.
7. Market goats must be under one year of age.
8. All market goats must be individually owned by the exhibitor for 60 days prior to the opening day of the Fair and in their complete care. All market goat entry documentation must be provided to the Nevada County Fair by June 12, 2020. Proof of ownership papers must be presented with entry.

Market-Ready: USDA Prime or Choice quality with 12th rib back fat range .08 - .12 most desirable, .13 - .22 back fat acceptable, average or greater conformation and cutability.

Not-Market-Ready: Good or lower quality grade with 12th rib back fat range <.08 or >.22; underfinished goats grading USDA good or lower, below average conformation or cutability. Not eligible to sell in auction.

NEVADA COUNTY BRED & FED MARKET GOAT

Entry Fee: \$5 entry

Limits: Limited to space available in ring

1. Entry must be made at time of market entry.
2. Market Goats which have been bred within Nevada County, by a Nevada County based breeder and raised by an FFA, Grange or Independent exhibition qualify. Market goats not bred within Nevada County do not qualify regardless of where or from whom they were purchased.
3. Only Market Goats shown in a market class and eligible for the Junior Livestock Auction qualify.
4. Class breaks, if necessary, will be determined by the Livestock Superintendent and Fair Management.
5. Copy of Bill of Sale must be included at time of entry and must verify the animal was bred in Nevada Co. A letter stating that it was bred and home-raised by the exhibitor is also acceptable.
6. At the judge's discretion, the judge may select the winner(s) without having all animals returned to the show ring.

- Grade, crossbred and unregistered purebred grade sheep to be judged strictly on grade sheep basis.
- A permanent ear tag or tattoo number is required.
- Animals which have been registered by a purebred breed association cannot be entered in this division.
- By the signature, as the owner or agent, on the online entry, the exhibitor also certifies that the sire of each animal entered in the following divisions for grade animals was either registered or purebred.
- Wether Dam/Sire Champions and Registered Breed Champions will compete for Supreme Champion.
- The Fair will not accept sheep from Scrapie "non-compliant" flocks, or animals that are Scrapie-positive or Scrapie suspects.
- A Bill of Sale or a letter documenting that the animal was home-raised, must be submitted with entries as proof of ownership.

- Market Sheep **MUST** have a Scrapie tag in the right ear.
- Market-ready and not-market-ready classifications will be subject to change in the event there are changes made in federal grading.
- Market lambs, minimum weight 100 pounds. Any lamb weighing over 150 pounds will not be "sifted" from the Livestock Auction, but will not be paid for over 150 pounds.
- All market lambs must be individually owned by the exhibitor for 60 days prior to the opening day of the Fair. All market lambs must submit entry documentation the Nevada County Fair by June 12, 2020. Proof of ownership papers must be presented.
- Danish System of Judging.
- All market lambs must have been slick shorn from the knee and hock up within 7 days of official Weigh-in. Fleece not to exceed 1/4" in length and fleece length must be uniform over entire body. Lambs with excessive wool will not be weighed until shorn.
- Market lambs must be docked such that the tail (dock) is healed and can be lifted from the exterior. Lambs that have no dock will not be eligible. Breeding animals born before January 1, 2000 are exempt.
- No icing of lambs.

Market Ready: USDA Prime or Choice quality with 12th rib back fat range .16 - .35 or greater conformation and cutability.

Not Market Ready: Good or lower quality grade with 12th rib back fat range <.16 or >.35; underfinished goats grading USDA good or lower, below average conformation or cutability. **Not eligible to sell in auction.**
