## RABBIT SHOWMANSHIP

**Judging** - Tuesday, August 11 following the Rabbit Breeding Show

**Pee Wee Showmanship:** Exhibitors are five to eight years of age as of January 1, 2020.

**Entry Fee:** Pee Wee, Novice & Junior - No Entry Fee • Senior \$5

**Deadline:** Friday, July 10

### Limits:

1. First place Senior Showmanship will compete Saturday, August 15 in Small Animal Master Showmanship.
2. See page 83 in showmanship class definitions.
3. Animals must be owned by exhibitor and entered by the exhibitor in an appropriate market, breeding or performance class.
4. The preparation for showing must have been done by exhibitor.
5. Note: Novice and Junior Showmanship judges may help members improve showmanship techniques while judging and will demonstrate proper procedures.
6. A large class may be divided into smaller groups for ease of handling and judging and to provide the maximum benefits of this learning experience for the Novice and Junior Showmen.

1. Meat pen exhibitors must be at least 9 years old as of January 1, 2020.
2. All rabbits must be identified by permanent tattoo. List ALL tattoo numbers on entry form. Only one meat pen may be shown & sold by the exhibitor.

3. Small animal meat pen exhibitors may enter a small animal meat pen and one large animal market class. These exhibitors can only sell one project and must declare which animal they will be selling to the Livestock Office as soon as they finish showing their large animal. If the meat pen qualifies as Champion or Reserve Champion, they may not show their large animal in their market class. They will be allowed to show in the large animal showmanship class.
4. Exhibitor may not have sold a market animal at any other county fair this year.
5. Exhibitor must be present during weigh-in and judging of the animals.
6. All market quality meat pens will be sold as resale at the Junior Livestock Auction. The Junior Livestock Auction is a terminal sale.

## Division 951 - Rabbit Meat Pen

Meat pens consist of three (3) rabbits each weighing a minimum of 3.5 pounds and not over 5.5 pounds. Rabbit meat pens entered must be owned by the exhibitor and be a part of a project under the exhibitor's care and management at least thirty (30) days prior to the opening of the Fair. Animals may not exceed seventy (70) days of age.

## OWNED AND BRED BY RABBIT MEAT PEN

A prize of \$50 for Champion and \$35 for Reserve Champion will be awarded to the Junior exhibitor whose Champion or Reserve Champion Rabbit Meat Pen was also bred by that exhibitor. Exhibitor must sign up at the time of entry to be eligible for this class award.
