#### Division 991 Class 1

Wednesday, August 9 at 6 pm (Receiving no later than 5:45 pm at Special Events Tent)

#### "Mermaid Delight Cupcakes"

You are allowed two separate entries in this class. If you choose to submit two entries, they must be different cake flavors. Decorations must exhibit "Sea You at the Fair!" theme. Entries may be made from scratch or may start with a mix. Must enter 12 standard-size cupcakes per entry, no mini or jumbo. Entries should be in a protective container. Judging will be based on taste and texture 60%, originality and creativity 20%, eye appeal 20%.
