## **Entry Fees:**

- \$15 per entry Ag Mechanics Auction
- No entry fee Ag Mechanics Welds

**Limits:** One entry per exhibitor. Nevada County FFA members only.

- Exhibitors must be enrolled in a high school agriculture mechanics pathway the prior year to the fair.
- The exhibitor's instructor must validate class enrollment and verify that the exhibitor was solely responsible for the construction and 70% of the completion of the project in the high school shop by signing the exhibitor's entry form.
- Ag Mechanics Auction projects must have an agriculture, western, outdoor, and/or recreation theme to be eligible.
  Eligibility will be determined by the exhibitor's instructor and fair management.
- No group projects allowed.
- Only first and second-place projects will be considered for the live Ag Mechanics Auction.
- Seventy (70) projects will be selected to sell in the live Ag Mechanics Auction.
- Third place projects that are unsafe or deemed unsellable will not sell in the live auction or silent auction.

- A silent auction for second place projects not selected for the live auction will follow the conclusion of the live auction until 9 pm on Friday, August 9, 2024.
- Exhibitors may establish a minimum for their project. Minimum bids must be declared to fair staff upon entry.
- To be eligible to sell, projects must compete in the chapter Ag Mechanics contest. Instructors will validate eligibility.
- Exhibitors may enter Ag Mechanics Welds and Ag Mechanics Auction.
- Auction commission to be determined by the Nevada County Fair Board will be charged to the seller to promote and finance the sale.
- Projects must be completed and operational upon receiving. No work, additions, or embellishments can be done once the project is received.
- No sponsor advertising allowed.
- · No private treaty sales allowed.
- Exhibitor must be present at the live auction and at the time of sale.
- Failure to follow limits may result in disqualification and non-sale.
